

THE HAMLETS TOWARDS MOSSANZONICO

ROUTE: Piazza Paracchini

DURATION: 2 hours approx

LEVEL: 100 meters

From our B&B Villa Rosalinda you take via Scalini going downhill to Piazza Paracchini, go right in Via Roma and then Via Tre Pievi. Go over the bridge onto the Franciscan Convent and go up towards Via Giampiero Matteri.

Near the carpentry shop, take via Fianessa, after about 100 meters turn left into via Campiedi and cross this small and cozy residential area between old and new homes. Continue on the paved road, along the houses of Mellia and reach the core of Mossanzonico.

The most characteristic part of the hamlet can be seen passing under an arched door that leads to a small square dominated by the use of stone.

Wandering around the dwellings you can see the old wash house of the hamlet, the small 15th century church of San Lorenzo and the house that was owned by Gian Giacomo Medici known as the Medeghino. From the church of San Lorenzo take the Via Medici, after a short stretch you can admire at number 9, an ancient house with the remains of frescoes dating back to 1500.



The walk now continues a little uphill, on a pleasant path overlooking the terraced vineyards towards the mountain, and the village towards the lake.

In this way it will be possible to reach in 10 minutes, the place called by the locals La Motta, where there is a fascinating building characterized by a tower, perched on a hill. Now you can go back along the same roads or continue for a hundred meters to reach Consiglio di Rumo; at the junction on the paved road immediately take the path on the left that goes up.

You will then reach the Crotti di Stazzona area (Avanzonico) and you will be able to descend again towards Dongo also staying on the road which crosses the Ponte della Regina (Queen's bridge) and continue downhill until you reach Via Iginio Gentile and then return to our B&B Villa Rosalinda in Via Scalini.
